






- The Respiratory Care Program is designed to prepare California licensed respiratory care practitioner at the registered respiratory therapist level.

New Program


HUMAN LACTATION

- Focuses on the physiology of attachment, bonding, and breastfeeding and the short- and long-term impacts of perinatal care practices on the mother-baby dyad
- Prerequisites: None, except Nutri 322 or Nutri 321 for Lactation educator/counselor certificate
- Length depends on certificate

 Certificate programs: Baby-friendly hospital staff, Lactation consultant assistant, Lactation educator/counselor
